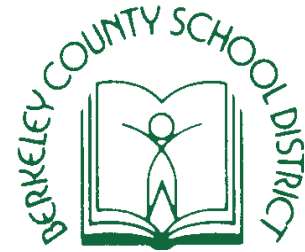

In order to minimize disruption to students' career paths, Cane Bay will open to 9th and 10th graders only in August, 2008.
